

Complete seven (7) Honors credits:

- x Typically, students complete four one-semester, one-credit Honors colloquium courses. These courses often incorporate an interdisciplinary approach along with creative teaching and learning methods. Each semester, the colloquium topics change—depending on students' interests.
- x The remaining 3 credits in Honors are available via the Honors independent study course (HR3014) entitled, "Explorations and Enrichment." This unique course allows students to explore their own unique academic, vocational, or personal interests through a project. The project culminates in a personally and professionally meaningful project which may take the form of a paper, presentation, video, etc.

Attend Honors Program events:

DeVal's Honors Program incorporates a holistic view of education. All students must attend a minimum of two Honors Program events during each academic year. They may attend two events in the Fall, two in the Spring, or one in each semester. These events may include program meetings, guest speaker discussions, local excursions, cultural experiences, etc.
